### PLEASE READ!

#### Student Parking Permit Rules-South Lot

1. Please park only in the south lot of the church (the lot bordered by 16th Street, across the alley from the church). Please do not park in the lot behind the church or the lot directly in front of the church at any time. These lots are reserved for church member use.
2. Display your permit at all times on your windshield above the registration and inspection stickers. **You are fully responsible for having a permit displayed in your vehicle at all times. If you change vehicles for whatever reason, you need to move your permit. St. John's will not replace your permit unless you show identifiable remnant of parking permit and pay the replacement fee. We recommend you use scotch tape to tape your permit to your windshield in the chance you will need to change vehicles. Vehicles without a displayed permit are subject to towing at your expense, regardless of whether you purchased a permit or not.** Replacement permits are \$10.
3. Parking is not permitted before 6:30 a.m. nor after 10:00 p.m.
4. Parking is not permitted on weekends.
5. Funerals will preempt all student parking. In the event of a funeral, there will be barricades blocking the parking lot entrances. We will attempt to notify you of parking lot closures the day before via email to allow for alternative arrangements to be made. If your email address changes during the semester you must notify the church office.
6. Please respect any barricades blocking the student parking area due to special church needs.
7. Do not park in any areas marked with a yellow curb or with signs marked "No Parking." Vehicles parked in these areas will be towed regardless of whether they have a permit or not.
8. Summer parking requires a separate permit. They will be available on our website towards the end of the spring semester.
9. Please park in designated spaces only. Vehicles parked on sidewalks, alleyways, driving lanes, exits and entrances will be towed without warning.
10. Speeding through the parking lots will not be tolerated due to the obvious endangerment of pedestrians.
11. Kindly avoid walking through the front parking lot in front of the church or landscaped areas except on paving stones provided.

**PLEASE NOTE: Your permit does not guarantee you a parking spot, only the right to park in the designated area if space is available.**

VIOLATIONS OF THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN POSSIBLE REVOCATION OF YOUR PERMIT AND SUBJECT YOUR CAR TO TOWING AT YOUR EXPENSE.
